The **Annenberg Circle** began in 1994 with the  
desire of members of the Leaders Society to  
do something beyond their annual giving.  
With their commitment of \$25,000,  
these dermatologists established the  
Dermatology Foundation's first  
major-giving program.

What began with these 33 key individuals from the  
specialty and the public has grown to include over

Endowment Fund to sustain the development
