

Gifts of Appreciated Stock Transfer - Guidelines



The Dermatology Foundation is a 501(c)(3) charitable organization. Gifts to the Foundation, including gifts of unrestricted stock, are deductible to the extent provided by law.

The easiest way to make a gift of stock is outlined below. This process is based on the premise that it is ordinarily more beneficial to the donor to give the actual unrestricted securities that have a capital gain and have been held for more than one year rather than to sell the securities and contribute the proceeds.

- The donor must write a letter of authorization or send the following Stock Gift Transfer form to his/her personal broker -- **with a copy to the Foundation** -- instructing the transfer of a given number of negotiable shares of named stock to the Dermatology Foundation.
- The donor's broker then contacts the Foundation to arrange a wire transfer of the securities directly to the Foundation's broker.
- Foundation policy is to sell the stock immediately upon receipt and credit the donor with a contribution equal to the stock's value on the date of transfer. ***To do this, it is imperative that the donor complete the following document and fax or mail a copy of it to the Foundation. Without this information, the Foundation will not be able to identify and properly credit the contribution to the donor.***
