That is why it is so important to maintain a pipeline of talented investigators with novel ideas.

Since 1964, the Dermatology Foundation has worked to drive advancements in patient care by investing in the early career research of those with the potential to achieve scientific breakthroughs. With your support, we can keep talented researchers working towards new insights and discoveries.

2022 Year in Review

We are especially grateful to our donors—physicians, dermatologic societies and companies—who share our commitment to the future of patient care. Your annual gifts make the important work of the Dermatology Foundation possible this year and every year.

As the 2022 calendar year ended and a new year began, we recognized that we are only one year away from the Dermatology Foundation's 60th anniversary. Since 1964, the purpose of the DF has remained simple but powerful. For nearly six decades, the DF identified and supported the early career work of investigators with great potential. Our research awards have helped launch outstanding research and academic careers and have helped make the practice of dermatology what it is today.

Our ability to support future thought leaders each year is made possible by our corporate sponsors, society partners, and individual supporters. **We are deeply grateful to our 2022 donors for their contributions of \$3.9 million this past year.** This included \$2.9 million from corporate and society supporters and \$1 million in gifts from physician and individual donors.

We were especially fortunate to receive two generous sponsorships for highly sought after mid-career awards. **Bristol Myers Squibb provided \$1 million to support a mid-career award** for psoriasis research. Shortly thereafter, **Sanofi-Regeneron provided a \$1 million donation to support research projects** that expand the understanding of dermatological issues impacting underserved groups in medicine. **Thanks to the generosity of all our constituents, we were able to award \$2.8 million in research funding to 57 physician-scientists and researchers.**

Last year, the DF continued to focus on a key aspect of its strategic plan—to modernize its operations and communications. Highlights include the implementation

of an online system for submitting and managing research award applications, a state-of-the-art fundraising system enabling streamlined giving and an expanded social media presence.

The annual Clinical Symposium was another high point of our activities, despite a last-minute relocation from Naples to Marco Island, Florida necessitated by the path of Hurricane Ian. Participants rated the program as robust with cutting-edge information. Many attendees have said that it is the best professional conference they attend each year. We are proud that many of the presenters, who are leaders in the field of dermatology, are former DF award recipients.

As the DF begins another year, its mission remains as essential as ever. There are still serious skin diseases and conditions with no effective treatment, and patients awaiting therapeutic breakthroughs. If you are not yet a donor, please consider joining us. Research Award Program

The Dermatology Foundation invests in early and mid-career researchers with bold ideas and the clear potential to achieve scientific breakthroughs that lead to new treatments. Identifying those exemplary ideas and researchers is the role of the DF's Medical and Scientific Committee and its Clinical, Medical, Surgical, Dermatopathology Panel, made up of 17 specialty leaders whose expertise spans the field. The committee and panel members review proposals following a rigorous process based on the National Institutes of Health study section.

Bristol Myers Squibb Psoriasis Research Award

This newly sponsored award supports the research of an outstanding mid-career investigator with an established trajectory of excellence in basic, clinical, or translational science. Funded research is centered on advancing the understanding or treatment of psoriasis. Made possible by Bristol Myers Squibb, this award provides \$100,000 in research dollars per year for up to three years.




